MINI FRITTATA RECIPE

In response to overwhelming demands following last week's 9.30 am morning tea, the following is the recipe for the Mini Frittata (all royalties to Penny Adams):

250g block Philly cheese
1 small red onion finely chopped
80g baby spinach leaves shredded
60g salami finely chopped

2tblspn plain flour

2 eggs lightly beaten
24 semi dried tomatoes
salt & pepper
1tblspn grated Parmesan cheese

In bowl combine Philly cheese, onion, spinach, flour, salt & pepper. Mix well.

Stir in beaten eggs until well combined.

Spoon into prepared muffin tins.

Top each muffin with tomato & sprinkle with cheese.

Cook 15 mins 180C or until set.

I put fresh cherry tomatoes on top instead of semi dried.

Bacon or ham can be used instead of salami. I have also made it in a slab tin. I used low fat "Philly".

Takes longer to cook than stated time in recipe (almost double) so best to check frequently after the 15 - 20 min mark.
